Criteria for the selection of Erasmus+ applications and SEMP

A.Y. 2024/2025 for exchanges in the A.Y. 2025/26

For legal purposes refer only to the Italian version. This translated version is intended only for a better comprehension for international students enrolled in the first year of the dSEA master's degree programmes

[...]

MASTER'S DEGREE COURSES: MASTER'S DEGREE COURSES: only those enrolled in the first year can apply for mobility in the second year

Each candidate may express up to three destinations by assigning a decreasing degree of preference. The assignment will take place by generating for each destination a ranking of candidates based on the score awarded on the basis of the selection criteria. Given that it is possible to be assigned only one destination for each call for application, the candidates who are successful in more than one destination are assigned to the one with the highest priority

***Penalizations:** for citizens of the country of destination (residence and/or degree) -50%.

For equal merit: the one who is academically older wins and if equal again, the one with the oldest age wins



Language knowledge

The 'main language' score is awarded to the language of the country if language = English, German, French, Spanish

The 'main language' score is awarded to the English language for a country with a minority language

Bonus language points are awarded to the English language if country language = German, French, Spanish.
 Bonus language points are awarded to the country language for countries with a minority language

Study efficiency

Scores to be considered 30 points. Scores will be rounded to two decimal places.

First call:

[...]

2 – First-year Master's students with an International qualification:

$$(\text{Score C} - \text{Score Min}) / (\text{Score Max} - \text{Score Min}) * x$$

where: Score-C is the candidate's admission score. Score-Min and Score-Max are respectively the lowest and the highest admission score recorded among all candidates enrolled to the call for dSEA destination(s) with this profile

3 – First year Master's students or PhD students graduated in Italy

$$(\text{Grade-C} - \text{Grade-Min}) / (\text{Grade-Max} - \text{Grade-Min}) * x$$

where: Grade-C is the degree mark obtained in the course of study considered for the candidate's admission, Grade-Min and Grade-Max are respectively the lowest and the highest degree marks recorded among all candidates enrolled to the call for dSEA destination(s) with this profile. A grade of 110 cum laude is counted as 111.

Second and further calls for applications:

$$1 - \text{All candidates: } (\text{CM-C} - \text{CM-Min}) / (\text{CM-Max} - \text{CM-Min}) * x$$

where: CM-C is the Candidate's coefficient of Merit; CM-Max is the maximum Coefficient of Merit recorded among all candidates enrolled to the call for dSEA destinations; CM-Min is the minimum Coefficient of Merit recorded among all candidates enrolled to the call for dSEA destinations

In the event of the absence of the coefficient of merit, the grade obtained at the end of the most recently completed course of study whose qualification determined access will be taken into account. This grade will be reported on a 30 basis.

Disability: 40% increase in the figure taken into account for the calculation of study efficiency to all students with recognized disabilities over 66% (see the appropriate section of the call for applications)



Annex

The certificates accepted are those recognised by the University Language Centre (<https://cla.unipd.it/test-linguistici/certificazioni/>), unless otherwise indicated in the call for applications for each destination. The main types of certificates are listed below. Certificates related to the list provided by the CLA will have to be issued by 1 January 2022 on.

For all languages, mother-tongue students are recognised a C2 level. Native speakers are considered to be students who have attended at least the entire secondary school cycle and obtained the relative diploma (corresponding to the DIPLOMA DI MATURITA') in a country in which the language being assessed is considered an official language.

Degree courses held entirely in a foreign language (English or other) will be considered equivalent to a certified level B2 (if a vehicular language) and C1 in the case of an official language.

Secondary school courses completed at international schools in Italy or abroad (e.g. International Baccalaureate - IB Diploma Programme) or within the framework of educational cooperation between ministries (e.g. ESABAC) are considered equivalent to a certified B2.

Curricular language examinations passed as part of a degree course will also be considered valid, with the stated level. In the absence of any indication, they will be considered equivalent to an A2 level. For more details on the levels attributed to UNIPD examinations by the various Departments, please refer to Annex 2.

TALs and other tests conducted by the Centro Linguistico di Ateneo (CLA) will be considered on the basis of the declared level.
